The evening was a great success. We were able to raise over £100 and the evening was enjoyed by all.

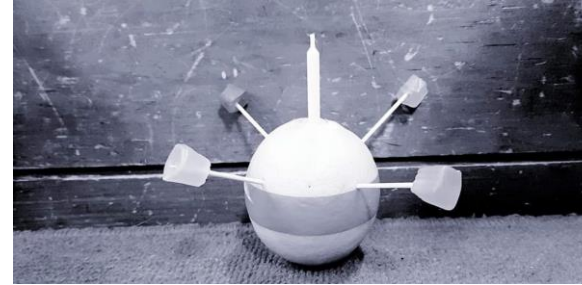


All of the young people were so respectful of each other, cheered each other on and applauded those who won trophies. We are hoping to hold the next youth games in the summer. Please keep a look out for details.
