In our story we heard about a son who wasted all his share of his father's money and his father still welcomed him home.


Christians believe that God loves them so much, that no matter what they do, if they say sorry God will always forgive them and welcome them home.

Follow the instructions to make a pig like the ones from the story.



What you will need:

- Toilet roll tube
- Pink paint or pink paper
- Button
- Ribbon
- Glue
- Black Pen
- Scissors



Paint or glue the paper to the toilet roll tube. Then cut two ear shapes at the top.

Stick on your button as a nose and draw two eyes just below the ears.



Cut a short piece of ribbon and ask an adult to curl it for you.

Stick the ribbon to the back of the tube to form a tail.

Perhaps you could make some of the other characters from the story and then act it out.
